Unfortunately, Ulee passed away in March 2022. The SAS community is creating this arts access fund in her name, in support of our mandate of *Arts for Everyone*.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to qualify, the applicant(s) must be recommended by a local agency with a Leisure Access program or equivalent.

PROCESS

Verify that the client has met the eligibility requirements.

- Complete the application form prior to submitting on behalf of the client.
- Review the Access Program with the client.

ACCESS PROGRAM

- Clients are eligible for a 50% discount off arts programs (\$200 credit max. More than this amount is able to be considered on a case-by-case basis by the Executive Director).
- Access funds can only be used once by the person identified.
- Clients must re-apply for any additional Access funds.
